### WHAT IS A CANCER NURSING SOCIETY?

A national cancer nursing society is a membership-based network whose goal is to represent the collective interests of their members and more generally the healthcare community. The society aims to improve cancer care for people affected by cancer by supporting cancer nurses.

National societies play a critical role in bringing cancer nurses together by providing a forum for members to collaborate, share expertise and knowledge, and support member initiatives. As representatives of the national cancer nurses' community, national societies serve as a channel for a constructive voice and input into EONS and vice versa.
