EONS and the UK's EU referendum

Dear colleague,

The European Oncology Nursing Society (EONS) is disappointed that the United Kingdom (UK) has chosen to vote to leave the European Union (EU).

EONS, as the oldest European cancer nursing society with more than 23,000 members, is proudly pro-European; its roots, which started growing over 30 years ago, have now spread to more than 28 Member States, and other European countries. EONS, from the very beginning, promoted partnership working and collaboration among European cancer nurses.

While the UK has voted to leave the EU, the implications of this are far from clear, for both the EU and the UK: the timelines for leaving the EU and what this means for UK residents living overseas accessing local healthcare have yet to be determined. What this means for EU members working as nurses and doctors in the UK also remains unclear.

As a pro-European organisation, EONS will need time to explore and understand the ramifications of the UK leaving the EU as nothing of this magnitude has happened before. EONS has several UK members on its Board and its current President is British; all of them remain strongly committed to working as a European collective. We will spend the next few weeks examining our statutes for any major impacts as well as talking with our colleagues in ECCO (who may also be affected by the vote).

We recognise that this new working environment may be concerning for some of our members. If you have any questions we invite you to share those with us by sending them to:
