


## EONS 2020: sources of Income

# EONS Cancer Nursing Index 2020 Overall scores

- Scores from 0-100, 22 items in 5 dimensions
  - Education and career development
  - Patient and Occupational Safety
  - Recognition
  - Working conditions and Impact
  - Workforce statistics
- Large variation between countries
  - Total mean score: 48 (min-max 16 -78)
- Highest total score; Ireland
- Differences between dimensions
- Some countries shore higher in education and career development and/or safety, others higher on working conditions and impact



# EONS CANCER PREVENTION PLAN

- A number of activities
- ECND 2022, cancer prevention targeting the general public
- 12-month campaign on cancer prevention (start May 2022)
  - Based on European Code Against Cancer
  - Focus on one recommendation for each month
  - Collaboration with other organizations

#### **EONS** workplace accreditation

- A core set of workplace standards that will foster safety for cancer nurses, and thereby for patients
- Use data from previous work (EONS safety survey, the European Cancer Nursing Index, Safety Webinars)
- Discussion on level of detail, generalizability between countries, follow-up
- Loosely based upon the JACIE framework used in haematology
- A bespoke accreditation tool that will empower cancer nurses to strive for excellence in the following areas:
  - Contact with cytotoxic and radioactive sources when planning pregnancy or during pregnancy
  - Personal Protective Equipment
  - Speak up!/Active promotion of a safety culture
