



EONS Senior Advisor

The Role in Summary

EONS Executive Board can appoint a person for the role of Senior Advisor, if needed for instance if one of the President-elect or Past-President roles are not appointed. A Senior Advisor is not elected by EONS membership.

This non-voting, voluntary Executive Board member is supporting and assisting EONS leadership and Board a maximum of one year. The Senior Advisor performs any duties nominated by the President and other duties as determined by the Executive Board. A Senior Advisor is typically the EONS Past President or other Executive Board Member in the end of their term to provide expertise and experience, important to the organisation's progress.

An EONS Senior Advisor must possess all of the essential qualifications required of all EONS Executive Board members, devote time for the assignment and follow the same reimbursement policy.
