

EONS Senior Advisor

The Role in Summary

EONS Board can appoint a person for the role of Senior Advisor, if needed for instance if one the President-elect or Past-President roles are not appointed. A Senior Advisor is not elected by EONS membership.

This non-voting, voluntary Board member is supporting and assisting EONS leadership and Board a maximum of one year. The Senior Advisor perform any duties nominated by the President and other duties as determined by the Board. A Senior Advisor is typically the EONS Past President or other Board Member in the end of their term to provide expertise and experience, important to the organisations progress.

An EONS Senior Advisor must possess all of the essential qualifications required of all EONS Board members, devote time for the assignment and follow the same reimbursement policy.
