



5th EONS 3-DAY PhD RESEARCH WORKSHOP 2024

DATES: 3rd June-5th June 2024, Ghent, Belgium

Venue: Ghent University Hospital/University Centre for nursing and midwifery Ghent University.

Closing date for applications is 3rd March 2024



Purpose

This exciting EONS Research Workshop is designed for oncology nurses who are at any stage of their doctoral studies and who would like to network with other PhD students and improve their knowledge, confidence, and expertise in oncology nursing research, as applied to their PhD.

Content

This 3-day workshop offers doctoral students an opportunity to discuss, develop and share ideas, progress, and gain European perspectives in relation to their doctoral research, within a supportive learning environment.

Requirements for the applicants:

To be eligible for participation, applicants must be:

- PhD student conducting research on a topic in oncology nursing;
- An EONS member, either through a National Oncology Nursing Society or Institute (Associate member) or as an individual member of EONS (or willing to become an individual member);
- Able to write and speak in English.

10 places are available.

Note: Applicants who have participated in earlier EONS Research Workshops or an EONS Master class will not be eligible.

What does the workshop fund?

- Registration fee;
- Three nights' accommodation;
- Lunches during the workshop;
- One evening dinner.

What does the workshop not fund?

- Successful applicants will be asked to pay their travel expenses. However, if flight cost alone exceeds €500, a maximum amount of €200 will be considered for reimbursement (insofar as EONS designated budget allows). It is important to note that partial reimbursement is for economy airline tickets only, and the presentation of receipts in keeping with the EONS travel policy.
- Personal expenses.
- Meals or lunches outside the workshop.

Submission format and content

The following information is required and should be provided in the online application form:

2. A letter of support from the applicant's PhD supervisor.
3. A document with the applicant's 2 Page CV.

Criteria of evaluation

Applications will be evaluated by the EONS research committee, on the following criteria:

- Formal eligibility of the applicant;
- Benefit of this workshop to the applicant's academic career in cancer nursing;

- Potential relevance of the PhD project to impact an aspect of clinical cancer nursing.

Reporting schedule

- Applicants are required to submit a short report within 2 months of attending workshop.
